



SUPPLEMENTARY CERTIFICATE PRINTING LIST 2020 – INFORMATION GUIDELINES

1. Purpose

Students who for various reasons missed out on the 2020 graduation and their certificates were not printed now have an opportunity to apply for the printing of their certificates. This is also for students who have outstanding certificates from earlier years.

2. Application Dates

Students wishing to apply for their certificates have a **2 weeks window** to do so, **from Monday, 05 October 2020 until Friday, 16 October 2020**. After this date, No more Applications for printing of Certificates will be accepted or processed. Students missing this second opportunity will have to wait until the Graduation Verification Process for 2021 is open, possibly around May 2021.

3. The process

Students applying for the printing of their certificates must submit their personal and qualification details to the graduation helpdesk/admissions officer at any nearest IUM Campus. Complete the Application Form For Printing of a Qualification - 2020, available on the University Website for download. If a student got some Exemptions, the exemption letter must be attached.

Students who began their studies in IUM in **2014 and later** need not to attach their transcripts as their marks are already available on the system for verification.

Students who did subjects in **2013 and Earlier** (before the implementation of the current system) need to submit their official academic records of 2013 and earlier as such marks are not available on the current system for verification.

4. Verification of Diploma in Education (Pre and Junior Primary) Graduands

ALL Students who have met the requirements for the award of a Diploma in Education (Pre and Junior Primary) but missed the graduation but now wish to have their certificates printed must do one of the following.



4.1. Students who were admitted in 2017 based on their Grade 12 results.

- a) Complete the Application Form For Printing of a Qualification - 2020, available on the University Website for download
- b) Submit **Original grade 12 Certificate AND a certified copy of the Grade 12 certificate** to verify their graduation eligibility.

4.2. Students who were admitted in 2017 through Mature Age Entry.

- a) Complete the Application Form For Printing of a Qualification - 2020, available on the University Website for download.
- b) Submit the Mature Age Entry admission letter or Mature Age Entry Test Results.

4.3. Students who were admitted in 2017 through other qualification(s)/Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)

- a) Complete the Application Form For the Printing of a Qualification - 2020, available on the University website for download
- b) Submit the RPL admission letter
- c) Submit a **certified copy of the other Qualification used as a basis for admission.**

5. Fees

There are no direct fees to be paid for this process.

6. Availability of the Certificates

Certificates should be done being printed in the first half of November 2020, the exact date depends on the number of applications received. Applicants will be notified by means of SMS when their certificates are available for collection.
