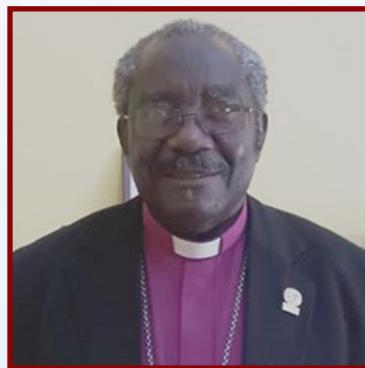

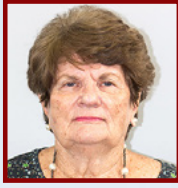

## ABOUT THE CANDIDATE

The graduand was born in Etunda village in Ruacana constituency, Omusati Region. She obtained her qualifications from Namibian and South African universities, specialising in pre- and junior primary education. She holds a master's degree in education and psychology from the International Christian University in Tokyo, Japan. She is an experienced educator in pre- and junior primary education. She is the current Head of Department for Pre- and Junior Primary Education in the Faculty of Education, at The International University of Management (IUM).

## SUMMARY OF THE STUDY

The study analysed the integration of the Language Policy for Schools in the training of pre- and junior primary student teachers at Higher Education Institutions in Namibia, with a focus on the use of Mother Tongue as a medium of instruction in pre and junior primary grades. Constructivism research paradigm underpinned the study. The population consisted of the lecturers, student teachers as well as pre- and junior primary school teachers. The sample was selected using purposive sampling. Focus group discussions and individual interviews were employed to gather data. The collected data was analysed using thematic analysis method. The results revealed that Mother Tongue instruction is key in fostering language development and academic performance of learners in pre- and junior primary phase. However, student teachers were faced with challenges in transitioning from English to Mother Tongue instruction during teaching practice. Key challenges include insufficiency of Mother Tongue teaching materials at teacher training institutions, code-switching from Mother Tongue to English and Mother Tongue translation difficulties. These challenges complicated the use of Mother Tongue by student teachers as a medium of instruction during teaching. In addressing this gap, the research findings were used to develop a framework for integrating Mother Tongue into the training of pre- and junior primary teachers. The framework manifests the effective integration of Mother Tongue instruction into teacher training curriculum, offsetting current instructional limitations currently experienced by pre- and junior primary teachers.

## ABOUT THE CANDIDATE

The graduand hails from Ashaandjela Village in Ondangwa Rural Constituency, Oshana Region. She obtained her qualifications from Namibian and South African University. She holds a Master of Education degree and a Bachelor Honours degree in Education from Rhodes University, and a Diploma of Education in African Languages from the University of Namibia. She has worked as a teacher, Head of Department, Advisory teacher, and the Head of Division for the Special Education in the Oshikoto Region. She is currently holding the position of Chief Public Education and Corruption Prevention Officer at the Anti-Corruption Commission of Namibia.

## SUMMARY OF THE STUDY

The purpose of the study was to assess the implementation of the Sustained Silent Reading Period (SSRP) in Namibian schools, with the aim of developing a theory-based training package for teachers to enhance stakeholders' competencies in implementing SSRP. The study employed a qualitative research methodology. The population comprised of School Principals, Heads of Departments (HoDs), teachers and learners. Document analysis, observation and interviews were used to collect data. A total of 49 informants were interviewed, 19 classrooms were observed, and relevant documents were analysed from two school libraries. The data were analysed thematically. Key findings indicated that stakeholders accepted the SSRP positively and are prepared to implement it. However, awareness of SSRP was minimal, with the National Curriculum for Basic Education of 2016 identified as the only primary source of information. A lack of capacity building among stakeholders was observed, with SSRP teachers struggling to fulfil their roles effectively. Insufficient support was noted regarding the SSRP teachers' manual. Most learners exhibited deficiencies in silent and self-reliant reading which diminished intrinsic motivation to engage in silent reading. A theory-based training package was developed to enhance school management and leadership skills related to the implementation and management of SSRP in Namibia. The package could be used to improve teachers' knowledge and understanding, build competencies in executing SSRP in classrooms, and assist in sourcing reading materials for SSRP, ultimately enabling SSRP achieving its desired goal of instilling a culture of reading among learners.

## ABOUT THE CANDIDATE

The graduand hails from Ongali Village located in Ombalantu, Omusati region. She has earned all her qualifications from Namibia's premier private university, The International University of Management (IUM). Her qualifications include an Honours Degree in Business Information Systems, a Postgraduate Diploma in Higher Education, and a Master's Degree in Business Administration. She is currently a Lecturer of Information Technology at IUM where she strives to impart her technical expertise and knowledge of Information Technology to students and society at large.

## SUMMARY OF THE STUDY

The study aimed to develop a strategic approach for leveraging Business Intelligence systems as decision support tools in Namibian corporate sector. Underpinned by a mixed-methods research methodology, the study utilised the research onion design in conducting the multifaceted inquiry. The population consisted of the major economic sectors in Windhoek. The sample was selected using both probability and non-probability sampling techniques. Data was collected using interviews and questionnaires. The qualitative data was analysed using thematic analysis aided by NVivo software. Quantitative data was analysed using statistical analysis techniques. Key results indicated that Business Intelligence can significantly enhance strategic decision-making in business organisations in Namibia. Despite this potential, there are predominant challenges in Business Intelligence utilisation, which relates to the absence of a conducive organisational culture, data integration hurdles, and insufficient activities that can potentially prompt the usage of Business Intelligence as a decision support tool. The study has advanced a significant contribution to decision support domains by developing a strategic approach to Business Intelligence applications which can be applied for decision-making by corporate organisations. To aid an effective implementation of the developed strategic approach, effective employees' training becomes necessary in all corporate organisations to mitigate resistance to Business Intelligence systems as a decision support tool. The study underscored the imperative and purposeful approach to Business Intelligence implementation, contributing valuable insights for organisational decision-makers and future Business Intelligence research endeavours.

## ABOUT THE CANDIDATE

The graduand hails from Alusati Pandulo Village in Onaanda area of Elim Constituency, in Omusati region. He holds a Master of Science in Integrated Water Resources Management from the Namibia University of Science and Technology (NUST), a Bachelor of Technology in Nature Conservation from the Nelson Mandela Metropolitan University, and a National Diploma in Nature Conservation from NUST. He has over sixteen years of experience in the field of Natural Resources Management. He is the Dean of the Faculty of Environment and Sustainable Tourism at The International University of Management (IUM), and the Coordinating Director of campuses at IUM.

## SUMMARY OF THE STUDY

The purpose of the study was to assess the impact of sand and gravel mining activities on the environment and the effectiveness of the regulations in place for controlling sand and gravel mining activities in the Cuvelai-Etosha Basin. The study adopted a mixed-methods research methodology. The population consisted of owners and employees of sand and gravel mining companies, subsistence farmers, individual landowners in the basin, and the staff members of regional councils, traditional authorities, Ministry of Environment, Forestry and Tourism, Ministry of Urban and Rural Development, Ministry of Mines and Energy, and Ministry of Agriculture, Water and Land Reforms. Data was collected using questionnaires, interviews, and focus group discussions. In addition, twenty-nine water samples were collected for the wet season, and sixteen water samples were collected for the dry season. A journal was used to record field observations and measurements of sand and gravel mining pits. Key findings revealed that sand and gravel mining activity has created jobs and improved the quality of life of the employees. However, due to deficiencies in regulations, the activity has resulted in deep trenches and environmental deterioration which has caused deaths, injuries and environmental pollution. To offset the environmental deterioration and threat to human life, the study developed a framework for rehabilitating gravel and sand mining pits. The implementation of the framework could help to optimise the potential benefits of gravel and sand mining activities to society, while at the same time mitigating threats to the environment.
