GENERAL REGULATIONS

APPLICATION AND REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

- Application forms are available at all IUM Campuses as well as on the IUM Website www.ium.edu.na
- Normal application period starts in July and ends in October yearly. Late application period starts from the 1st – 30th November
- All students [Non-degree, Undergraduate, Postgraduate, and Research] must register each year in January/February.
- Postgraduate Research Students shall be supervised ONLY if they are registered.

UNDERGRADUATE ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Admission to Stand Alone Programmes requires 20 points in the best 5 subjects with a D symbol in English at NSSC Ordinary/Advanced Subsidiary or equivalent.
- Admissions to Diploma in Education (Pre and Junior) requires NSSC Ordinary/Advanced Subsidiary or equivalent with a minimum of 23 points in the best five subjects (including a minimum D symbol in English and any Namibian Language) on the IUM's evaluation scale.
- Admission to Bachelor Degrees and Integrated Bachelor Honours Degrees Program requires 25 points in the best 5 subjects with a D symbol in English at NSSC Ordinary/Advanced Subsidiary or equivalent.
- Admission to Master Degree Programmes requires a Bachelor Honours at NQF Level 8 or equivalent.
- Admission to Doctoral (PhD) Programmes requires a Master Degree NQF level 9 or equivalent.

MATURE AGE ENTRY REGISTRATION

- Must be 25 years old or over in the year in which admission is sought
- Three years relevant working experience
- Must have a passed grade 10 Certificate

NB: Besides that prospective applicants should pass the entry Aptitude Test of IUM

Please Note:

- Non – Namibian qualifications must be evaluated by the Namibia Qualifications Authority (NQA).
- Applicants seeking exemptions for prior studies should apply as early as possible.
- All copies submitted with application forms must be certified.

 - Are 25 years old or over in the year in which admission is sought
 - Have at least 2 years' teaching experience at the same level and provide a suitable reference from a recognised public or private official/school.
 - Must have a passed Grade 10 Namibian Certificate

QUALIFICATION DURATION

Minimum: 3 Years - Maximum: 5 Years.

Mode of study: Full time or Part time

BACHELOR OF EDUCATION HONOURS (PRE AND JUNIOR PRIMARY) (NQF LEVEL 8)

ADMISSION /ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- Grade 12/NSSCO/NSSCAS or equivalent with a minimum of 25 points in the best 5 subjects (including English Language minimum D symbol and a minimum of a D symbol in a Namibian Language) on the IUM's evaluation scale
- A recognized qualification at NQF level 6 or equivalent.
- Mature age entry, provided that they:
 - Are 25 years old or over in the year in which admission is sought
 - Have at least 2 years' teaching experience at the same level and provide a suitable reference from a recognised public or private official/school.
 - Must have a passed Grade 10 Namibian Certificate

OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

- **For NSSCAS holders: Students will be exempted from NQF level 4 modules which are related to their previous field of studies with "A" to "D" symbol, access to the curriculum.**

QUALIFICATION DURATION

Minimum: 3 Years - Maximum: 5 Years.

ADMISSION /ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

BACHELOR OF EDUCATION HONOURS (SECONDARY EDUCATION) (NQF LEVEL 8)

ADMISSION /ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- Grade 12/NSSCO/NSSCAS or equivalent with a minimum of 25 points in 5 subjects (including English Language minimum D symbol) on the IUM's evaluation scale
- A recognised qualification at NQF level 6 or equivalent.
- Mature age entry, provided that they:
 - Are 25 years old or over in the year in which admission is sought
 - Have at least 3 years' teaching experience at the same level and provide a suitable reference from a recognised public or private official/school.
 - Must have a passed Grade 10 Namibian Certificate

OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

- **Other requirements specifically for students who wish to specialize in a school subject includes a minimum of a D symbol in the subjects/related subjects they intend to specialize in, except for English, Mathematics and any Namibian Language, where the students must obtain a minimum of a C symbol from one examination sitting to specialize in these subjects.**
- **For NSSCAS holders: Students will be exempted from NQF level 4 modules which are related to their previous field of studies with "A" to "D" symbol, access to the curriculum.**

QUALIFICATION DURATION

4 Years - Maximum: 6 Years.

4. DEPARTMENT OF POSTGRADUATE STUDIES EDUCATION

BACHELOR IN EDUCATION: EDUCATIONAL LEADERSHIP, MANAGEMENT AND POLICY EDUCATION HONOURS (NQF LEVEL 8)

ADMISSION /ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- Candidates who already have level 7 or 6 (NQA or equivalent) recognized qualification with experience of at least three years in education or in a related organization.

QUALIFICATION DURATION

2 Years- Maximum: 3 Years.

Mode of study: Part-time or online/e-learning mode

POSTGRADUATE DIPLOMA IN EDUCATION (NQF LEVEL 8)

ADMISSION /ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- A candidate must hold a minimum of a recognized Bachelor degree at NQF Level 7 or equivalent.
- The undergraduate record must demonstrate that the candidate has acquired two (2) school subjects' content knowledge during three consecutive years of studies at the university (please see the checklist for IUM Postgraduate Diploma in Education prospectus for available subject combinations at the Secondary level).

QUALIFICATION DURATION

1 Year - Maximum: 2 Years

Mode of Study: Part-time or online/e-learning mode integrated with block release mode

ADMISSION /ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- A candidate must hold a recognized minimum qualification at NQF Level 8, and working as a lecturer, trainer, tutor or instructor at a tertiary institution or institution of higher learning, or organization training departments or equivalent, subject to approval by faculty postgraduate admission committee. In addition, Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) will apply.

QUALIFICATION DURATION

Minimum: 1 Year - Maximum: 2 Years.

Mode of study: Block release integrated with online/e-learning mode

MASTER OF EDUCATION – EDUCATIONAL LEADERSHIP, MANAGEMENT AND POLICY EDUCATION (NQF LEVEL 9)

This qualification targets professionals such as school principals, vice principals, senior teachers, subject teachers, deans, department heads, staff development trainers, team leaders and other educational professionals in public and private sectors.

ADMISSION /ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

To be admitted in the Master of Education in Educational Leadership, Management and Policy, an applicant:

- Must be in possession of a Bachelor Honours Degree in Education or an equivalent relevant qualification at NQF level 8 with an average of 60% and above.
OR
- Must have Bachelor Honours Degree in Education or an equivalent relevant qualification at NQF level 8 with a minimum of two years teaching experience.
- Upon completion of this qualification students will be able to articulate to a Doctor of Philosophy in Education at NQF Level 10.

Note: The above criteria reflect the minimum admission requirements into the programme. The Faculty reserves the right to set extra admission criteria into the programme as can be determined and approved by the IUM Senate.

QUALIFICATION DURATION

2 Years - Maximum: 4 Years.

Mode of study: Block release mode integrated with online/e-learning mode

DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY (PHD) IN EDUCATION (NQF LEVEL 10)

ADMISSION /ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- To be admitted to this qualification a student must have: A Masters of Education Degree or an equivalent qualification registered at NQF Level 9 in the relevant specialization being applied for.

QUALIFICATION DURATION

Minimum 3 years / Maximum 6 years

Mode of Study: By research and completion of non-credit bearing courses on block release mode

- A Diploma in Water Resources Management NQF Level 6;
- Any equivalent diploma at NQF Level 6
- Students may also enter through mature age provided that they:
 - Are 25 years old or over in the year in which admission is sought
 - Have at least 3 years' relevant experience
 - Must have a passed grade 10 Certificate

Mode: Full time/part time
