RESEARCH TITLE: AN INTERVENTION FRAMEWORK TOWARDS ADDRESSING CHALLENGES FACED BY RURAL WOMEN ENTREPRENEURS IN OHANGWENA REGION, NAMIBIA

ABOUT THE GRADUAND

The graduate hails from Ondema Village in Okongo Constituency, Ohangwena region. She holds a Master of Science in Business Management, and a Bachelor Honours Degree in Legal Studies and Social Justice, all from Manchester Metropolitan University in the United Kingdom. In addition, she holds a Diploma in Health and Social Care from Guild Vocational Training, an affiliate of Liverpool University, and a Diploma in Adult Education from the University of Namibia. She has over fifteen years of combined experiences in entrepreneurship, administration, management and academia. She is currently a role player in the real estate industry, advancing socio-economic growth through property development and management.

SUMMARY OF THE STUDY

The study analysed the challenges that faced rural women entrepreneurs in the Ohangwena region, Namibia, with a focus on their entrepreneurial skills and the impact of entrepreneurial training on their empowerment. A qualitative research methodology underpinned the study, with a case study design as the research design. A total of sixty rural women entrepreneurs and five coordinators from a Vocational Training Centre, were purposively sampled. Data was collected using interviews and focus group discussion and attracted thematic analysis.

Key findings revealed that a significant number of rural women entrepreneurs were deficient of essential entrepreneurial skills and faced numerous challenges including inadequate entrepreneurial training and empowerment, limited access to finance, cultural feminine expectations and the dominant effects of a patriarchal society. The study highlighted the need for a tailor-made entrepreneurial training for rural women empowerment, that is contextual and facilitated in indigenous languages. In addition, central government and other stakeholders' support in the form of funding and provision of equipment becomes essential. In terms of policy implications, the study advanced evidence-based insights that could be used as a baseline for developing future policies on rural women empowerment and entrepreneurship in general. In addition, the outcome of the study bears significant implications to practice, having advanced a customised Entrepreneurship Training Manual for rural women entrepreneurs. The framework in the Training Manual could help to improve future entrepreneurial practice of rural women as it provides them with a blend of hard and soft skills, which would in turn enhance their entrepreneurial capabilities and boost their business growth.

ABOUT THE GRADUAND

The graduate originates from Ondaanda Village in the Ohangwena region. He holds a Master's degree in Development Studies, specialising in Health Development and Local Economic Development, from the University of the Free State, South Africa; a Bachelor of Nursing Sciences in Health Services Management and Community Health from the University of Namibia; and a Diploma in Nursing and Midwifery Sciences from the University of Namibia. He has more than three decades of experiences in the Health Services Delivery and Management. Currently, he is a Senior Dental Nurse in the Faculty of Health Services and Veterinary Medicine, at the University of Namibia.

SUMMARY OF THE STUDY

The study intended to assess the stakeholders' perceptions of the effectiveness of Local Economic Development (LED) initiatives in Town Councils. The study aimed at developing a framework for the effective implementation and functioning of Local Economic Development initiatives for Town Councils as local governments in Namibia. The study employed a mixed-methods research methodology, carried out using a sequential explanatory design. Data was collected using questionnaires, interviews and focus group discussions. The collected data was analysed using statistical and thematic analysis methods.

Key findings revealed that, despite Local Economic Development initiatives being a common element in local governments, some key stakeholders were not well conversant with the strategic interventions whose implementation could realise the effectiveness of Local Economic Development initiatives in town councils. This deficiency has averted Local Economic Development initiatives from being impactful in local governments, necessitating a framework for coordinating Local Economic Development initiatives within local governments. A framework for improving the functionality of the Local Economic Development initiatives was developed as an outcome of the study. In terms of practice, the framework provides strategic, tactical and operational guidance on the effective operationalisation of Local Economic Development initiatives in local governments. By considering the framework, local governments would be better positioned to support national development priorities and optimise the impact of Local Economic Development initiatives to society. Regarding policy implication, the framework provides guidance on how future policies related to local governments could be better planned, developed, implemented and monitored for a great impact.

Since the fifteenth century, universities worldwide have awarded honorary degrees in recognition of significant achievements and positive societal impact. The International University of Management (IUM) proudly continues with this venerable tradition, to honour individuals who have made exceptional contributions and impact to education, leadership and social development.

INVOCATION

Today, it is my profound honour to present one of Namibia's distinguished daughters, **Mrs. Marcolette "Colette" Rieckert,** whose life's work is boldly inscribed in the chapters of private education in Namibia.

Allow me, therefore, to summarise her life, achievements and contributions.

Mrs Rieckert was born on 2 April 1972 in a modest suburb of Cape Town, South Africa.Her formative years were marked by resilience, perseverance and a commitment to excellence, culminating in her recognition as a top achiever at Brackenfell High School. She distinguished herself both academically and athletically, serving as Head Girl and Dux Learner.

Following matriculation, she pursued a Bachelor of Accounting degree at the University of Stellenbosch, where she further honed her intellectual acumen and leadership skills. Mrs Rieckert went on to complete her B. Compt (Honours) and CTA through UNISA.

REFLECTIONS

The nominee, Mrs. Marcolette "Colette" Rieckert, hails from a humble yet loving family. She is the second of four daughters born to Mr Johan and Mrs Marie Wiese. Though raised in modest circumstances, the warmth and affection that filled her home nurtured a spirit of resilience and purpose.

In 1992, she married Dr Johan Rieckert and later relocated to Namibia, her husband's homeland, where together they have built both a family and a shared legacy of service. They are blessed with three children:- Jano and twins Henco and Marné.

Mrs. Marcolette "Colette" Rieckert story deserves to be shared globally, for it is one that inspires all. She is the modern-day heroin, a commoner who carved her way to the top, refusing to be defined by a challenging background. Revolutionaries were never cowards but they faced obstacles head-on with courage and resilience. Mrs. Marcolette "Colette" Rieckert equally benefited from her family's steadfast support for her education, which became the foundation of her remarkable journey.

Upon completing her studies, Mrs. Marcolette "Colette" Rieckert embarked on a distinguished career encompassing academia, professional practice and entrepreneurship. She lectured in Accounting and Auditing at the University of Namibia, nurturing a generation of learners with rigorous scholarship and instilling a culture of financial stewardship.

She went on to manage business operations at the Windhoek International School, before establishing her own Accounting and Auditing Practice.

Her dedication to education and nation-building extended beyond the classroom. She served with distinction in several governance roles, including:

- Representative of Private Schools on the National Advisory Council for Education (2017–2023);
- Chairperson, Association of Private Schools in Namibia (2020–2025); and
- Vice-Chairperson, National Advisory Council to the Minister of Education (2021–2023).

Through these roles, she championed collaboration between the public and private education sectors, ensuring that quality learning becomes a shared national mission.

ACHIEVEMENTS AND IMPACT
